to all according to fairness."

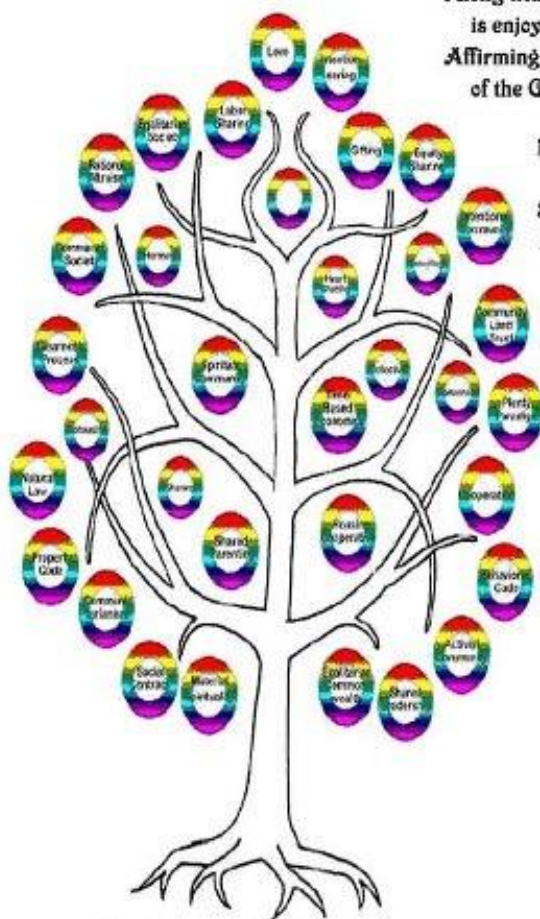
As scarcity is essential

Utopia Literacy 101: Communitarian Designs and Trends

Peace Studies + Women's Studies + Environmental Studies = Utopia Studies

A utopia begins with a group of people co-creating a village. Terms for all forms of village community include: in the USA the term "**intentional community**"; in Europe the term "**ecovillage**" is used; in Israel the term "**kibbutz**" is used.

Theories and designs for utopia are classified in different ways. The most common categories are:

- Religious/Spiritual, with unified-beliefs, or secular with pluralist beliefs;
- Cultural identity can be rigid, stable, and stuck-in-time, or open and changing with the times;
- Social stratification ranges from authoritarian, class society to participatory, egalitarian society;
- Economic processes range from sharing common property to sharing private property, plus mixtures of the two;
- Governance systems used are from consensus to democracy to autocracy;
- Geographic location from rural to small town to suburb to urban;

Of the different methods for classifying intentional communities the most critical is the economic design, since this impacts most of the other characteristics. There are three basic economic forms used in communities, and each uses a different type of legal incorporation:

1. **Sharing common property**, e.g., communal and monastic societies use tax-exempt nonprofit forms;
2. **Sharing private property**, e.g., cohousing using the condominium; housing and land cooperatives using the cooperative corporation; class-harmony as sole-proprietor or small-group partnership; equity-sharing using tenants-in-common; and coliving using the for-profit corporation;
3. **Mixtures of the two** include; community land trusts using nonprofit legal forms, and limited-equity co-ops using either nonprofit or cooperative corporations.

Notice in the above that there are more different forms of private-property than of common-property-sharing communities. This is the major trend in the communities movement: away from the sharing of commonly-owned property to the sharing of privately-owned property. The trend toward private-property-sharing was advanced in 2010 with the invention of the land co-op or real estate

investment cooperative (REIC), which is likely to become the largest and fastest-growing form of intentional community, at least in the USA.

Reasons for the trend away from communal society include:

- Financing is harder to secure for communal groups which often have to create community-owned business, while private-property-sharing communities involve members with jobs and careers that can get 30-year mortgages;
- The dominant culture is based on private property rather than common property, so the change to sharing private property is a simpler change than to any form of the sharing of common property;
- Parents often take their children out of the communal group, and for those who do not, their children growing up in the lifestyle often do not accept their parents' communalism and leave when they become adults. For those reasons, communal groups often do not want to support children since they will almost certainly leave communal society.

People still value communal society since the communal lifestyle takes us back to primitive tribalism before the invention of money and civilization. This is a unique experience of total immersion in cooperative culture that changes how people think and live, even long after leaving communal society.

The **Utopia Literacy Project** encourages people to create local associations for connecting with others in their area who are involved in cooperatives and communities, and those interested in Utopia Studies or in gifting and sharing lifestyles, for sharing information about the communities movement and for aiding the co-creation of community. The name offered for such associations is "**regional commonwealth**," as in the Denver Commonwealth or the Louisa Commonwealth, to use two very different examples.

An Allegory Presenting Lifestyles of Gifting and Sharing

People typically know more about the characters, places, and events of Middle-earth than they know about intentional community, so an allegory relating the people, places, and histories of real-world intentional communities to the high-fantasy of J. R. R. Tolkien's *Lord of the Rings* provides an entertaining way for people to learn about the range of different types of alternative lifestyles in existence and available today.

The **Antifa Allegory** takes the theory of **Dark Enlightenment**, now influencing at least our current national government which is based on the political-economic model of **cameralism**, and relates that theory to Tolkien's story of an evil force seeking to control all the races of Middle-earth. Cameralism is a form of pre-capitalist mercantilism developed in Prussia, formerly in northeast Europe from the 16th to the first half of the 20th century. Cameralism is the monarchist-libertarian governing model preferred by the current President of the United States. **September, 2026.**

In the Antifa Allegory, **money serves as the One Ring in a hobbit's pocket**, and businesses are forms of magic rings creating wealth, yet that wealth is a trap that controls and consumes the population.

In response, the Fellowship of Intentioneers serves to encourage and support the creation of non-monetary, time-based economics of labor-gifting and labor-sharing. While in monetary economics differential wages and salaries reward different types of work, in time-based economics, all labor benefiting the community is valued equally, including domestic reproduction as well as income-generating production.

Correspondences of Fantasy to Reality

One Ring—Money. Rings of Power—All businesses, whether organized via debt-based or time-based economics.

The Fellowship's Mission of Destroying the One Ring by casting it into Mount Doom is an analogy for removing from our minds the power of money and its values of possessiveness and competition that it has upon us, enabling us to turn to forms of time-economics supporting values of sharing and cooperation. This can be of varying degrees of difficulty depending upon one's intellectual and emotional constitution.

Elves—Egalitarian communal societies, whether spiritual, multi-faith, or secular, have gone furthest in bending the powers of Darkness (debt-based monetary system) toward service of the Light (time-based labor-sharing systems) with their Rings of Power.

Dwarves—Survivalist communities or "prepers" may be isolationist and politically conservative (e.g., Libertarian) yet may also resist the Darkness.

Numenorians—Spiritual intentional communities: Christian, Buddhist, Hindu, Islamist, New Age, Pagan, Unitarian Universalist, Native American Spiritual or other, building societies based upon the values of sharing and cooperation found in religious ideals.

Humans—Secular and multi-faith intentional communities: ecovillages, cohousing communities, community land trusts, housing/land cooperatives, etc.

Hobbits—Those who ignore, don't care about, or are oblivious to the contest of values between the Light and the Darkness (i.e., sharing and cooperation versus possessiveness and competition) which may include average citizens, members of military, police, or other civil servants. This may be due to being far removed from the actual contest, or to being self-absorbed, or in denial of the contest, yet individuals may find themselves suddenly in the thick of it of no intent of their own, and may end up serving either the Light or the Darkness.

Wizards—Those who frame and teach economic systems, whether debt-based or time-based, serving either the Darkness or the Light.

Ring Wraiths—Upper managers of the monetary economy such as the Federal Reserve and other central banks, the World Bank, etc.

Sauron and Morgoth—Those at the highest levels of global monetary system consultation and coordination.

Trolls, Goblins, Orcs, etc.—Those who prey on others: thieves, predatory lenders, terrorists, liars, politicians, etc.

Balance personal wants with the needs of society and nature. When our preferred lifestyle is one of sharing and cooperation there are three primary concerns: gender-equality, social justice, and human-and-nature symbiosis. All of these concerns may be considered forms of partnership. Since we cannot have a gender, a racial or ethnic, and a human-and-nature partnership with a patriarchal religion, a Partnership Spirituality is needed.

Cultural engineering, or intentioneering, for a gifting and sharing culture requires changing from patriarchal Abrahamic faiths to partnership as a religious ideal. Religion is one of the three primary aspects of culture, along with governance and economics, all of which must serve the same ideals.



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
